ZeumMasters are leaders, role models, creative individuals, and the face of Zeum—San Francisco’s innovative arts and technology museum for kids and families. ZeumMasters improve their ability to express themselves through art, acquire skills in communication, teamwork, and achieving their goals. Highly motivated teens with a strong interest in learning about art and technology, working with people of all ages, and becoming community leaders should apply!

This is a structured employment and training internship for teens interested in developing advanced creative and technical skills. The ZeumMasters program emphasizes leadership development, community service, and mentorship. High school youth (ages 14-18) are selected each year to facilitate the Zeum experience by assisting visitors of all ages. During the program, ZeumMasters receive training to advance their creative and technical skills from beginner to expert level in Zeum’s core areas such as writing and producing shows, creating clay animation movies, performing in music videos, and composing digital art.

Zeum is a non-profit, community-based art and technology museum serving children, youth and families in the San Francisco Bay Area and beyond. Zeum is the only museum in the Bay Area where individuals of all ages, backgrounds, communities and learning styles combine hands-on use of animation, digital technology, electronic media, traditional and non-traditional materials, and the power of their imaginations to create high quality stories, movies, music, art and more.
