Museums located within 90 miles of each other are **excluded** from the program unless that exclusion is lifted by mutual agreement. Your museum is responsible for **removing** local nonparticipating museums from this list. To receive Passport Program benefits at a participating science center or museum, you must live more than 90 miles from the center/museum you wish to visit. Admissions staff reserve the right to request proof of residence for benefits to apply. Science centers and museums requesting proof of residence are marked by **(✓IDs)**. Acquaint yourself with the admittance policies (denoted by "F:") of Passport Program sites before visiting. The Passport Program entitles visitors to free **general** admission. It does not include free admission to planetarium/theater presentations nor does it include museum store discounts and other benefits associated with membership unless stated otherwise.
